1. THE PICTURE OF SPIRITUAL TRANSFORMATION.

“Jesus entered Jericho and made his way through the town. There was a man there named Zacchaeus. He was the chief tax collector in the region, and he had become very rich. He tried to get a look at Jesus, but he was too short to see over the crowd. So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree beside the road, for Jesus was going to pass that way. I must be a guest in your home today.’ Zacchaeus quickly climbed down and took Jesus to his house in great excitement and joy. 2. THE PROOFS OF SPIRITUAL TRANSFORMATION.

➤ **Growing love for God's word.**

➤ **Growing love for God's people.**

“We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love our brothers. Anyone who does not love remains in death.” 1 John 3:14 (NIV)

➤ **Growing desire to obey God.**

“And we can be sure that we know Him if we obey his commandments.” 1 John 2:3 (NLT)

➤ **Never ashamed of God's Gospel.**

“I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.” Romans 1:16 (NIV)

“For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.” 1 Corinthians 1:18 (NIV)

3. THE PROCESS OF SPIRITUAL TRANSFORMATION.

❖ I put my faith in Jesus Christ.

"If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved." Romans 10:9-10 (NLT)

❖ Jesus puts His spirit in me.

"You, however, are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ. But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness." Romans 8:9-10 (NIV)
